

Yolo County Elections Will Host Voter Education and Outreach Workshops September 26-30

Yolo County Elections will conduct Voter Education and Outreach Workshops for the November 8, 2022, General Election, beginning Monday, September 26 and continuing to Friday, September 30 to increase accessibility and participation of eligible voters with disabilities and with limited English proficiency.
